## ENROLLMENT FOR 2020-2021

**Time is running out to register for Hallsville 4-H. Please register now if you want to be a member in our club!!!**

Enrollment ends online October 31st

Enrollment state and county dues are \$30 **PAY AT TIME OF ENROLLMENT ONLINE**

There will be a list of projects and leaders at the club meeting. If you sign up for a project that is not on the list, your parents might have to lead the project. Please sign up for only the number of projects you can handle. It is suggested for the first 2 years of 4-H you sign up for three or less. This is very realistic.

**All online enrollment forms for 4-H members, parents, and project leaders and other volunteers must be completed and enrollment fees paid by October 31. Your child will not be enrolled in 4-H until all is completed and cannot participate as a 4-H member. All parents and project leaders and other volunteers; new project leaders and parents must take the 4-H online orientation course. All project leaders and other volunteers must fill out the background check. Background check is online this year. Parents, you need to fill out the Youth Photo Release form for your child at time of enrollment.**

**If you want to take candy making or child care project you will need to contact the extension office and talk to Christal or Ryan and they will add it for you. The online system won't let you add it.**

## HALLSVILLE GO-GETTERS 4-H CLUB REQUIREMENTS TO STAY IN GOOD STANDING

1. Attend the majority of club meetings (12-14 held).
2. Attend the majority of project meetings (minimum of 6 hours) of each project enrolled and complete the requirements of the project leader.
3. Participate in two community service projects.
4. Serve on a club committee.
5. Participate in club fund-raisers.
6. You are asked to sell Countywide BBQ tickets or work at the county BBQ.
7. Suggested you exhibit at the Hallsville Youth Fair and Boone County Fair.
8. Suggested you fill out project record at end of the year for each project.
