- 6. You are asked to sell Countywide BBQ tickets or work at the county BBQ. (If they have one in the future)**
- 7. Suggested you exhibit at the Hallsville Youth Fair and Boone County Fair.**
- 8. Suggested you fill out project record at end of the year for each project.**
