HALLSVILLE GO-GETTERS 4-H CLUB REQUIREMENTS TO STAY IN GOOD STANDING

2. Attend the majority of project meetings (minimum of 6 hours) of each project enrolled and complete the requirements of the project leader.

3. Participate in two community service projects.

4. Serve on a club committee.

5. Participate in club fund-raisers.

6. You are asked to sell Countywide BBQ tickets or work at the county BBQ. (If they have one in the future)

7. Suggested you exhibit at the Hallsville Youth Fair and Boone County Fair.

8. Suggested you fill out project record at end of the year for each project.
