2022-2023 Hallsville Go-Getters 4-H Club Committees

Budget Committee: Club leader, 4-H President and Treasurer will serve on this committee. Committee will propose a budget for the year and present to club for approval in **December**.

Recreation Committee: **Hallsville Go-Getters Officers** will be the recreation committee with the club leader's assistance. There will be recreation at some of the club meeting organized by the club officers.

National 4-H Week (October, 2022): Club Officers - Present ways to club for them to promote National 4-H Week. Examples: hang up posters about 4-H in Hallsville businesses, wear 4-H shirts to school, send articles and pictures to newspapers and etc.

The Promotion, Recruitment and Communications Committee:

Chair: George Donovan & Tammy Keffer

This committee would be responsible for coming up with recruitment ideas and events to let area youth know about the learning opportunities our 4-H Club offers. This would involve forming a working relationship with area schools and businesses as well as other 4-H clubs for the promotion of the 4-H program.

This committee would also be responsible for club communications. This would include input on the design, maintenance, and promotion of the Club's website. It would also include the Facebook page and input into the monthly Go-Getter newsletter

Social Committee: Organize social events for the club in **October 2022, February 2023 and August 2023. Present to club to vote and see if they want to have the event.**

Fund Raising Committee: Cindy Montague - All fundraising ideas must be presented to the club for a vote. Committee organizes fundraiser and explains to members how they will help with the fundraisers if the club approves. Burger & Fry Night in November and May.

Concession Stand: Chair: Wendy Sallee- 4-H is in charge of the concession stand during our youth fair in June 2023. This committee will be responsible for getting workers and calling the workers before the event to inform them of the day and time they are scheduled to work. Parents and members both work in the concession stand. We also serve concessions for George Auction Service sales.

Community Service: Bring community services ideas to club for a vote. Committee will organize community service events and let members know how they can help.

Float Your Boat Committee: Chair: George Donovan

Float Your Boat competition raises money for food bank. Float Your Boat is mid-Missouri's original cardboard boat regatta and The Food Bank's premier spring fundraising event. Teams race one-of-a-kind cardboard boats across Bass Pro Shops Lake while attendees cheer them on as they sail – or sink – toward prizes. Float Your Boat is a popular family friendly event.

Float Committee: Jeremy Donovan & Jessica Estrada - This committee is responsible for putting together floats for parades. You will purchase candy for the parade and find kids to ride on the float for parades.

County BBQ Ticket Sales Committee: Distribute tickets to families in the spring for the Boone County 4-H BBQ; keep track of how many tickets are sold, money, etc. This is a fundraiser for the Senior Council, so this is a very important committee. Money raised will be used for 4-H scholarships, camps, trips and etc.

County BBQ Cooking Chickens: Our club cooks chicken for the county wide BBQ. We need many families involved with this committee. This is an all-day event but everyone has a great time

Boone County 4-H County BBQ Drive Thru

Our club is responsible for running the drive thru. Setting up, serving and clean up.

Christmas House Decorating Committee: In November, send out information about contest (have city clerk put on the Hallsville utility bills, newspaper, posters in businesses, send notices to all the churches about our contest. Find judges, select winners, issue prizes and send winners information and pictures to newspaper.

Christmas Gifts Committee: Honey Wehmeyer & Anita Lee - In November get names of families in need and their Christmas wish lists. Families should be in Hallsville area. Purchase items and distribute to these families before Christmas.

Christmas Food Baskets Committee: Heather Adkins - Purchase food, make baskets and distribute to needy families and to the elderly in our community for Christmas.

Christmas Fun Event: Chair: Lacie Smith: Organize event. It will be December 17, advertise, set up, clean up, decorate and other duties associated with the event.

Santa Breakfast Committee: Organize and carry out plans for breakfast on December 17.

Hallsville 4-H/FFA Youth Fair: Chair: June 15,6,17, 2023 -Livestock shows will be chaired by Hallsville FFA, small animal show, youth arts exhibits, shooting sports, vendors will have their own chair and carry out the duties of their event. Non-4-H events held at our fair will have chairs also. Main chairs will oversee the fair to make sure all events are running smoothly and if they need anything they will see they get what they need. We need one person in charge of advertising, this is the key to success. The first meeting will be in January 2023.
