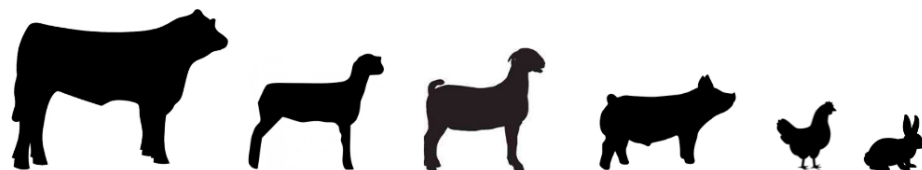
SMQA TRAINING

BOONE COUNTY 4-H RECOGNITION NIGHT

If you are interested in helping with the organization of the Boone County 4-H Recognition Night please come to the meeting on March 23rd at 6:30 pm at the LeMone Building. This committee plans the dinner, gets judges for the award applications, gets prizes and a few of the duties.

Here is a scenario of the award process:

Each 4-H member will fill out a project application form and submit to extension office by the deadline

The application will require youth to reflect on their past 4-H experiences and provide thoughtful responses. 4-H awards recognize youth for their engagement and learning in the 4-H program, focusing on the skills they have gained. Once completed, a 4-H awards portfolio may be a useful tool that can be referenced when completing future job, college, or scholarship applications.

Award winners are selected through an application process that showcases their knowledge, skills and experiences in their chosen 4-H project area. Participation in the 4-H awards program helps all applicants develop skills to prepare for their future such as communication, time management, goal setting, and record keeping.

Applications are carefully reviewed by selection committees and winners are announced at Boone County 4-H Recognition Night in November.

Recognition for 4-H award winners include different types of awards. The program recognizes 4-H members in different project areas in both Junior (8-10 years old) and Intermediate (11-13 years old) and Senior (14-18 years old) age divisions.

Applications are carefully reviewed by selection committees and winners are announced at recognition night in November.

HALLSVILLE GO-GETTERS 4-H CLUB REQUIREMENTS TO STAY IN GOOD STANDING

1. Attend the majority of club meetings (12-14 held). (7)
2. Attend the majority of project meetings (minimum of 6 hours) of each project enrolled and complete the requirements of the project leader.
3. Participate in two community service projects.
4. Serve on a club committee.
5. Participate in club fund-raisers.
6. Suggested you exhibit at the Hallsville Youth Fair and Boone County Fair.
7. Suggested you fill out project record at end of the year for each project.

2022-2023 Hallsville Go-Getters 4-H Club Committees

Social Committee: Organize social events for the club in **October 2022, March 2023 and August 2023. Present to club to vote and see if they want to have the event.**

Community Service: Amy Hempen Chair: Bring community services ideas to club for a vote. Committee will organize community service events and let members know how they can help.

Recreation Committee: **Hallsville Go-Getters Officers** will be the recreation committee with the club leader's assistance. There will be recreation at some of the club meeting organized by the club officers.

The Promotion, Recruitment and Communications Committee:

Chair: George Donovan & Tammy Keffer

This committee would be responsible for coming up with recruitment ideas and events to let area youth know about the learning opportunities our 4-H Club offers. This would involve forming a working relationship with area schools and businesses as well as other 4-H clubs for the promotion of the 4-H program.

This committee would also be responsible for club communications. This would include input on the design, maintenance, and promotion of the Club's website. It would also include the Facebook page and input into the monthly Go-Getter newsletter

Concession Stand: Chair: Wendy Sallee - 4-H is in charge of the concession stand during our youth fair in June 2023. This committee will be responsible for getting workers and calling the workers before the event to inform them of the day and time they are scheduled to work.

Parents and members both work in the concession stand. We also serve concessions for George Auction Service.

Float Your Boat Committee: Chair: George Donovan

Float Your Boat competition raises money for food bank. Float Your Boat is mid-Missouri's original cardboard boat regatta and The Food Bank's premier spring fundraising event. Teams race one-of-a-kind cardboard boats across Bass Pro Shops Lake while attendees cheer them on as they sail – or sink – toward prizes. Float Your Boat is a popular family friendly event.

Float Committee: Jeremy Donovan & Jessica Estrada - This committee is responsible for putting together floats for parades. You will purchase candy for the parade and find kids to ride on the float for parades.

Fund Raising Committee: All fundraising ideas must be presented to the club for a vote. Committee organizes fundraiser and explains to members how they will help with the fundraisers if the club approves. Burger & Fry Nights are automatic fundraisers in November and May every year.

Hallsville 4-H/FFA Youth Fair: Chair: Elaine George June 15,16,17, 2023 –Livestock shows will be chaired by Hallsville FFA, small animal show, youth arts exhibits, shooting sports, vendors will have their own chair and carry out the duties of their event. Non-4-H events held at our fair will have chairs also. Main chairs will oversee the fair to make sure all events are running smoothly and if they need anything they will see they get what they need. We need one person in charge of advertising, this is the key to success. The first meeting will be in January 2023.
