# BOONE COUNTY 4-H RECOGNITION NIGHT – November 19<sup>th</sup> at 5 pm

Watch your emails for the new award form applications and instructions!!

Here is a scenario of the award process:

Each 4-H member will fill out a project application form and submit to extension office by the deadline

The application will require youth to reflect on their past 4-H experiences and provide thoughtful responses. 4-H awards recognize youth for their engagement and learning in the 4-H program, focusing on the skills they have gained. Once completed, a 4-H awards portfolio may be a useful tool that can be referenced when completing future job, college, or scholarship applications.

Award winners are selected through an application process that showcases their knowledge, skills and experiences in their chosen 4-H project area. Participation in the 4-H awards program helps all applicants develop skills to prepare for their future such as communication, time management, goal setting, and record keeping.

Applications are carefully reviewed by selection committees and winners are announced at Boone County 4-H Recognition Night in November.

Recognition for 4-H award winners include different types of awards. The program recognizes 4-H members in different project areas in both Junior (8-10 years old) and Intermediate (11-13 years old) and Senior (14-18 years old) age divisions.

Applications are carefully reviewed by selection committees and winners are announced at recognition night in November.

## HALLSVILLE GO-GETTERS 4-H CLUB REQUIREMENTS TO STAY IN GOOD STANDING

1. Attend the majority of club meetings (12-14 held). (7)

2. Attend the majority of project meetings (minimum of 6 hours) of each project enrolled and complete the requirements of the project leader.

- 4. Serve on a club committee.
- 5. Participate in club fund-raisers.
- 6. Suggested you exhibit at the Hallsville Youth Fair and Boone County Fair.
- 7. Suggested you fill out project record at end of the year for each project.

## 2022-2023 Hallsville Go-Getters 4-H Club Committees

Social Committee: Organize social events for the club in October 2022, March 2023 and August 2023. Present to club to vote and see if they want to have the event.

<u>Community Service</u>: Amy Hempen Chair: Bring community services ideas to club for a vote. Committee will organize community service events and let members know how they can help.

<u>Recreation Committee:</u> Hallsville Go-Getters Officers will be the recreation committee with the club leader's assistance. There will be recreation at some of the club meeting organized by the club officers.

## The Promotion, Recruitment and Communications Committee: Chair: George Donovan & Tammy Keffer

This committee would be responsible for coming up with recruitment ideas and events to let area youth know about the learning opportunities our 4-H Club offers. This would involve forming a working relationship with area schools and businesses as well as other 4-H clubs for the promotion of the 4-H program.

Please send a separate registration email for each child. All projects being entered by that child can be sent in one email (see example below).

Remember to tell your project leader if you are going to bring a project to the Youth Arts Fair, so they can be sure a judge will be there to work with you.
