Here is a scenario of the award process:

Each 4-H member will fill out a project application form and submit to extension office by the deadline

The application will require youth to reflect on their past 4-H experiences and provide thoughtful responses. 4-H awards recognize youth for their engagement and learning in the 4-

H program, focusing on the skills they have gained. Once completed, a 4-H awards portfolio may be a useful tool that can be referenced when completing future job, college, or scholarship applications.

Award winners are selected through an application process that showcases their knowledge, skills and experiences in their chosen 4-H project area. Participation in the 4-H awards program helps all applicants develop skills to prepare for their future such as communication, time management, goal setting, and record keeping.

Applications are carefully reviewed by selection committees and winners are announced at Boone County 4-H Recognition Night in November.

Recognition for 4-H award winners include different types of awards. The program recognizes 4-H members in different project areas in both Junior (8-10 years old) and Intermediate (11-13 years old) and Senior (14-18 years old) age divisions.

Applications are carefully reviewed by selection committees and winners are announced at recognition night in November.
