They must also plan to attend a higher-education institution, college or university either located in Boone County or that is a member of the Columbia Chamber of Commerce - Central Methodist University, Columbia College, Moberly Area Community College, Stephens College or the University of Missouri. Any application submissions that are incomplete will not be considered.

The scholarship recipient will be recognized at the 2024 Columbia Chamber of Commerce Agricultural Recognition Banquet. If you are selected, we hope you will be able to join us at this event. Scholarship must be used in the 2024-2025 academic year.
